



This must be the most private and convenient swimming pool possible. Wake up feeling like a swim? No need to travel further than the bedroom door, because there the pool is waiting.

It is also the most integrated design imaginable, as it flows right inside the home to be bordered by the terrace, bedroom and ensuite. The pool has been built on the first floor so it sits above the lounge room, offering diners a romantic view of the blue water floating above them.

While the pool is an ingenious concept, it couldn't be produced without considerable thought and effort. Two things that had to be overcome — besides the basic structural effort of putting the pool on the first floor — were controlling sound and condensation.

Condensation could have been a problem because of the temperature differences between the walls of the home and the water. Noise was potentially a problem because sound could transfer into the home when people were in the pool.

The problems were overcome by situating silicon bearings and a waterproofing membrane between the structure of the house and the reinforced concrete structure of the pool.

Now, the beautiful pool is part of the home and part of the lives of the owners. They can exercise at a whim in perfect privacy, and entertain their guests in a stunning intimate environment.
